

MATERIAL:

- GFRC Off the form, Designer Terrazzo, ECC hand troweled finish which provides an organic look to the surface with light and dark shadings

SUPPORT STRUCTURE IF REQUIRED FOR A TIMBER STYLE FIRE THAT WILL SIT DIRECTLY ON THE HEARTH

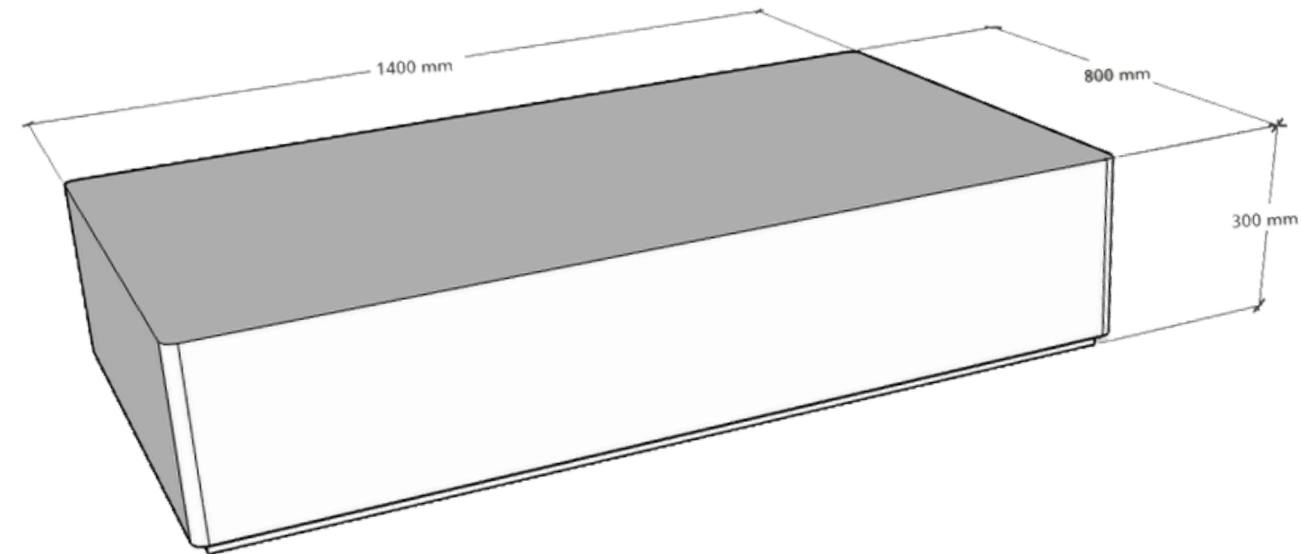
- Cutout in the top of the concrete fire hearth the same size as the base of the selected fire
- Welded steel tube construction subframe if required in the Platform range
- Bolted into the underside cavity of the concrete hearth
- Heat proof fibre cement panel fitted to the top of the steel frame
- 5mm steel sheet fixed to the top of the FC Sheeting

INSTALLATION OF THE FIRE:

- Fire to be installed by a qualified tradesperson
- Base of fire to sit evenly on the steel sheet

NOTES:

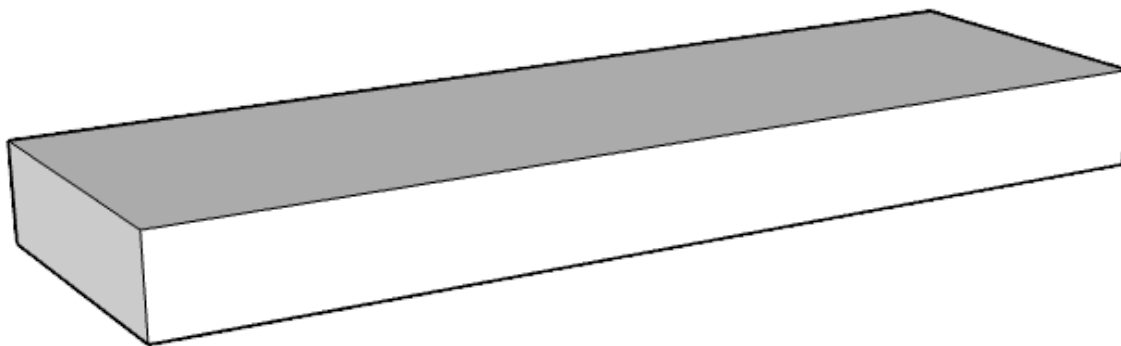
- 12 month structural warranty on the concrete
- Concrete is stain resistant - harsh chemicals when left on the concrete surface may affect the sealer coating
- Due to expansion and contraction of the concrete as a result of heat, micro cracks may appear which are generally not structural in nature and are normal in concrete
- All dimensions provided are approximate due to the nature of this product. Slight variations may occur in sizes, colour and finish due to the hand-made nature of the product
- Placement of the cutout will depend on the selected fire, walls and floor materials used



PLATFORM - 300mm Edges and Hollow underneath

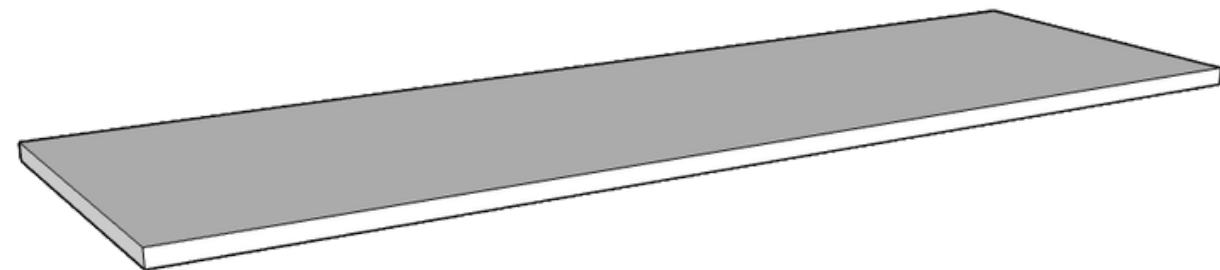
Includes a 10mm shadow line along the base and support frame underneath

- 1200 x 600mm / 300mm high
- 1400 x 600mm / 300mm high
- 1600 x 600mm / 300mm high
- OPTION to add a heat proof panel under the fire if needed (this will be required if it is a timber fire and the heat sits directly on the concrete hearth ie. NO legs on base of fire)



SHELF - 120mm Edges and Hollow underneath

- 1200 x 600mm / 120mm high
- 1400 x 600mm / 120mm high
- 1600 x 600mm / 120mm high



S SHEET- 40mm thick

- 1000 x 600mm / 40mm high
- 1000 x 800mm / 40mm high
- 1000 x 1000mm / 40mm high
- 1200 x 1200mm / 40mm high
